


Go to Google Photos, click on your favorite photo. The share button is highlighted. It is on the left of the icons.




Under share, there is a create link, click that. Copy the url in that create link box.




Go to Embed Google Photos, https://www.labnol.org/embed/google/photos/ and paste that link into the box, click the I am not a robot box, and hit the generate button.



Scroll down, and copy the Direct Image Link that is generated.



Go to VAF, and start a post. Hit the insert image button. It is just to the right of the Insert Link. It is highlighted in the image below. When you click that insert image, a box pops up, in the space provided, paste the link that you got from Embed Google Photos. The very last bit of the really long link will probably be this, =w2400. That makes the image 2400 pixels wide, which is too wide in my opinion. So I change that to =w800.



You can now preview post, and your photo should show up. When you hit Submit Reply, then everyone can see you post with the photo from Google in it. I am honestly not sure how long this will work. As of today, 10/6/2020 it works fine.
